We would like to invite you and your child/ren to an exciting, relaxing, fun-filled, hands-on and motivational Summer Camp. The camp, run by our Aftercare Program, will be May 28 -July 19<sup>th</sup> 2024.

**To attend Summer Camp your FACTS (tuition/cafeteria) account has to be paid in full.**

Please take a moment to complete the registration form and return to the office. Once your application is received a \$35 deposit per child will be added to your FACTS account.

**We will be closed Thursday July 4<sup>th</sup> in observance for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.**

The cost for Sacred Heart School Summer Camp is \$150.00 per week per child for full-time campers. Part-time campers are \$30.00 per day per child. The hours of the camp will be 6:30am-6:00 pm.

Please be prepared to present I.D. when picking up your child. Let everyone on your pickup list know that this is our procedure. Parents of children who are not picked up promptly at dismissal time will be charged \$1.00 per minute that the parent is late.

Please monitor your payments and balances online @ FACTS SIS financial tab. All fees must be paid through your FACTS account. Any exceptions must be pre-approved by the principal. Drop off and Pick up will be in the rear of the cafeteria (enter through the gate/ pre-k playground) drop off 6:30-7:30am and pick up 3:00-6:00 pm. At any time, we could be in the gym, courtyard or computer lab; if no one comes to the rear door of the cafeteria during pickup; please call the **Aftercare cell number 901-268-8700.**

Parents are to provide a lunch each day for their child; please feel free to send extra snacks for your child.

Children can wear school appropriate shorts, tennis shoes, sandals, tank tops; etc. Children can bring a nap mat to use for naptime. Children can bring their bicycle and they must have a helmet.

Children will have access to the computer each day to be able to complete summer work and interact with enrichment activities.

There will be some presentations to match the weekly activities.

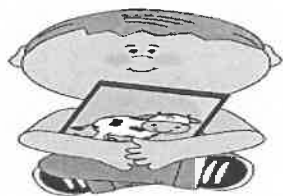
