We have made it to the final week of the year! It has been wonderful working with you this year. We have celebrated many milestones.

Each year during our spring parent-student conferences, we ask parents to complete a survey about our school. The students and staff also complete the survey during class. I am working on a state of the school report to come out during the summer. I did want to share our top ratings with you now. Parents overwhelmingly listed our school provides a safe environment for students. Parents and staff also noted that our purpose statement is clearly focused on student success. Our students listed that all teachers set high standards for student learning. In the state of the school report, I will address our high marks as well as our low marks. I will list our action plans for the new year.

Several families have not turned in new Catholic verification letters for the 2023-2024 school year. Catholic families must have their parish complete a Catholic verification letter each year. You will not receive the Catholic tuition rate without your letter.

We will need to cancel this summer's basketball camp. We did not have enough participation. Parents will be refunded their money.

I have attached our 2023-2024 school calendar and our new tuition scale. The Board of Directors met at the end of April to approve the budget. Our tuition increase will go toward new safety measures as well as an increase in staffing costs.

Tuition Scale for the 2023 - 2024 School Year

For 2023-2024, the estimated cost to educate each child at Sacred Heart School is: **\$10,345**
 This **does not** include tuition assistance, cafeteria, aftercare or extracurricular activities.

Tuition Assistance, based on financial need, may be available and is funded by the generous donors of Sacred Heart Southern Missions.

To operate Sacred Heart School during the 2023-2024 school year, in addition to school generated income, Sacred Heart Southern Missions (SHSM) anticipates spending **\$1,610,910** to fund the difference between expenditures and school income.

Donations to Sacred Heart Southern Missions to help cover the difference between what you are charged in tuition and what it costs to educate your child(ren) are always gratefully accepted.

Regular tuition for a single child in Kindergarten to 8th grade: **\$7,027**
 Tuition is discounted by **25%** for additional children.
 Tuition is discounted by **15%** for registered Catholic families of SHSM parishes.
